SCHOOL CANTEEN AND TUCKSHOP NOTICE

As a result of both the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health guidelines with regard to school canteen and school tuck shop foodstuffs we have had to make some adjustments to what we offer.

We will no longer be offering Bake House pies but will be providing mostly Heart Tick (National Heart Foundation approved) foods and the Healthy Kids Choice foods.

Although we will continue to sell our food at very competitive prices we have had to make some small increases. As from Monday 5th May, the first day of term 2, we also had some changes to the lunch and tuck shop items available from the canteen.
